BDA Funds Downtown Facade Improvements

In December 2013 the BDA received \$250,000 from the Brunswick Development Corporation to assist downtown commercial property owners with exterior facade improvements. The BDA brought together a group of local experts in the fields of architecture and historic preservation to develop a grant application and review proposed projects. Matching grants are available (maximum \$10,000 per project) to qualifying property owners and businesses.



To date, the RDA has distributed \$105.000 in

grant funds and the total investment made by property owners exceeds \$265,000. Looking good, Brunswick! For more details on this program, please contact the BDA office.
